EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Only a Life or Ordinary Member whose name is not on the Absent Members' List may submit the application for Membership Transfer Scheme and be placed on the Membership Transfer List.
2. An Ordinary or Life Member shall not be placed on the Membership Transfer List unless his or her monthly subscriptions for the preceding twelve (12) months have been paid in full when they are due.
3. The Membership Transfer List and the Waiting List are on a first come first served basis.
4. When the proposed Applicant is elected as an Ordinary Member of the Club and full payment of the prevailing entrance fee has been received by the Club, the net payment after deduction of the processing fee and other dues owed to the Club will then be paid to the Transferor.
5. In the event that the application is not approved or the proposed Applicant is not formally elected to the Club, the Transferor shall continue to be liable to pay all subscriptions until notification by the Club that a new proposed Applicant has been elected and the Club has received full entrance fee.
6. The Club shall be not liable to account to the Transferor in the event that the proposed Applicant is not elected as an Ordinary Member of the Club.
7. All applications for Membership Transfer Scheme must be submitted via the stipulated forms and officially acknowledged by the Club.
8. An Ordinary or Life Member may request to transfer his/ her membership to his/ her child or grandchild, regardless of that child's nationality, provided the child is at least twenty-five (25) years of age and is on the Waiting List.

MEMBERSHIP TRANSFER SCHEME – RULE 23A

23A(i) The Club shall maintain a Membership Transfer List in respect of Ordinary and/or Life Members who wish to relinquish his or her membership of the Club, and a Waiting List in respect of non-Members who have requested to be admitted as Ordinary Members (“the Applicant”) of the Club and have been proposed for membership to the Club.

The Membership Transfer List and the Waiting List shall operate on a first come first served basis. The Membership Transfer List and Waiting List shall each comprise two (2) subsidiary lists, one (1) subsidiary list in respect of Singaporeans and the other, in respect of non-Singaporeans.

23A(ii) An Ordinary or Life Member seeking to transfer his or her membership (“The Transferor”) shall make a request in writing to the Club to be placed on the Membership Transfer List. Whether such an Ordinary Member should be placed under the subsidiary list for Singaporeans or the subsidiary list for non-Singaporeans shall be determined by the citizenship of the said Ordinary Member as at the time he or she was admitted to the Club, except for the provisions of Rule 23B.

23A(iii) An Ordinary Member shall not be placed on the Membership Transfer List unless his or her monthly subscriptions for the preceding twelve (12) months have been paid in full when they are due (in accordance with Rule 30).

23A(iv) An Ordinary Member seeking to access the Membership Transfer Scheme in respect of his or her Ordinary Membership under this Rule shall continue to be liable for monthly subscriptions until the membership has been transferred to the new member.

23A(v) If a Member who has made a request under Sub-Rule (ii) is subsequently placed on the Absent Members’ List or becomes in arrears of his monthly As at 1 November 2019 20 subscription under Rule 30, that Member shall be removed from the Membership Transfer Scheme.

23A(vi) Subject to the other provisions in this Rule, the Club may, at its discretion, assist a Life or Ordinary Member on the Membership Transfer list to identify an Applicant wishing to apply for Ordinary Membership to the Club and the Club shall be entitled to payment of a processing fee equal to 33% of the prevailing entrance fee by way of deduction of the entrance fee received from the Applicant.

23A(vii) The Club may place the membership of an Ordinary Member on the Membership Transfer List where the following conditions are met:

- (a) the Club has notified the Transferor on the Membership Transfer List in writing of the Club’s prior arrangements to transfer the said Members’ membership; and
- (b) the vacancy so formed is for the purpose of satisfying the demand on the waiting list.

23A(viii) Notwithstanding Rule 11(iii), the Transferor seeking to transfer his or her membership under Sub-Rule (ii) may request the Club in writing that the membership be transferred to his or her child or grandchild, regardless of that child’s nationality, provided the child is at least twenty-five (25) years of age and is on the Waiting List.

23A(ix) When there is a request pursuant to Sub-Rule (viii), the Club shall consider such request.

Where, in exercise of the Club's discretion, a transfer of membership is sanctioned pursuant to this Sub-Rule,

- (a) the child or grandchild of the Transferor shall be resident in Singapore; and
- (b) the child or grandchild of the Transferor shall pay the full entrance fee as prescribed under Rule 29.
- (c) the Club shall at all times maintain the prevailing mix of Singaporean and Non-Singaporean Members except for the provision under Rule 23B.

23A(x) Upon notification by the Club that it has received the full entrance fee and shall proceed to transfer the Transferor's Ordinary Member's membership, the Transferor shall immediately cease to be an Ordinary Member in accordance with Rule 23A(xi).

23A(xi) An Ordinary Member electing to offer his Ordinary Membership for transfer under the Membership Transfer Scheme will receive payment as soon as the Club has received the full entrance fee from the incoming Ordinary Member, in one of the following ways: As at 1 November 2019 21

- (a) A cash payment equal to the prevailing Entrance Fee for Ordinary Memberships in accordance with Rule 23A(vi); or
- (b) A cash payment equal to the prevailing Entrance Fee for Ordinary Memberships less the application fee for a Silver membership should the Committee approve the Transferor's application for a Silver Membership, subject to the outgoing Ordinary Member submitting such an application; or
- (c) Monthly instalment payments over five (5) years as received by the Club where the applicant is unable to raise the relevant financial facilities from external financial institutions to pay the Transferor the prevailing entrance fee in full upon approval of his/her admission to the Club.

The Club is not required to advance the Transferor the relevant entrance fee net of the prevailing processing fee and/or the prevailing Silver Membership fee and conversely, the Transferor is not required to accept payment for transfer of his Ordinary Membership by instalments. The method of payment shall be agreed between the Transferor and the Applicant pursuant to the provisions under Rule 23A(xi).

23B. When there is a request pursuant to Rule 23A(i) and 23A(ii), the Club shall consider such request. Where, in exercise of the Club's discretion, a transfer of membership is sanctioned pursuant to this Sub-Rule, the Club shall at all times maintain the prevailing mix of Singapore and Non-Singapore Members but in the event that the Club has been unable to procure a non-Singaporean applicant to acquire Ordinary Membership to the Club after twelve (12) months of the Ordinary Membership held by a senior non-Singapore Ordinary Member aged 75 years and above, being on the Membership Transfer List, then the Committee may classify that senior Non-Singapore Ordinary Membership as an "open category" Ordinary Membership and available for transfer to both Singapore and Non-Singapore applicants.
